

## Bill of Materials - Sasquatch 12-33

Note: This is the minimum material needed plus a 15% waste factor. Some builders will require more wood flour and resin than others.

Plywood: 4' x 8' [122 cm x 244 cm] sheets 3 each

Epoxy Resin (and hardener): 1.5 gallons [7.6 Liters]

Fiberglass Tape, 6 ounce, 4" 10 yards (9 M)

[200 g/m<sup>2</sup>, 10cm]

Fiberglass Cloth 6 ounce, 50" wide 9 yards (8.2 M)

[200 g/m<sup>2</sup>, 127cm]

Wood Flour: 2 quarts

Additional material will be required for gunwales, seating, etc.

Note: Amounts listed are minimum quantities. It may be more economical to purchase epoxy and fiberglass in slightly greater quantities. Check with your vendor for pricing details.

## **Light Weight Options**

**CAUTION:** Building with this option will result in the hull not being as strong and will take more skill to *BUILD AND USE*. We only recommend this option to those who have intermediate paddling skills and know how **not** to push the limitations of a kayak.

**Substitutions:** Use 3mm plywood and 4-ounce fiberglass cloth.
