

## Bill of Materials – South Wind 15-30

Note: Additional material will be required for varnishing or painting.

<u>Plywood:</u> 4' x 8' sheets [122 x 244 cm] 4 each

Epoxy Resin (and hardener): 2.5 gallons (9.5 L)

Fiberglass Cloth, 6-ounce, 50" wide [200 g/m<sup>2</sup>, 127 cm] 11 yards (10 M)

Fiberglass Cloth, 4-ounce, 30" wide [135 g/m<sup>2</sup>, 76cm]: 6 yards (5.5 M)

Wood Flour: 2 quarts (2 L)

## **Light Weight Options**

**CAUTION:** Building with this option will result in the hull not being as strong and will take more skill to *BUILD AND USE*. We only recommend this option to those who have intermediate paddling skills and know how **not** to push the limitations of a kayak.

**Option:** Use 3mm plywood and 4-ounce fiberglass cloth for entire hull
